Drop & Go Observations

- All three airports have a similar percentage of Drop & Go OPs compared to Total OPs (23% ASE vs 21% EGE vs 22% JAC)
- ASE Drop & Go OPs rises busy season compared to JAC, but similar to EGE.
- Significant EGE and JAC Drop & Go OPs occur year round despite having very large GA ramp space.
- The majority of Drop & Go OPs are not tied to ramp space constraints, however it appears to be more of a factor at ASE.
 - ASE has 38% of Drop & Go OPs involving CO Airports
 - EGE has 23% of Drop & Go OPs involving CO Airports

Today's Business Jet Fleet

- Estimates range from approximately 21,000 to 23,000 total non-airline owned jet aircraft world-wide.
- Approximately 14,200 business jet aircraft in North America
- Estimate for next decade = approximately 8,000 deliveries (700 to 800 per year)
- 2019 FAA Business Jet Report = 4,533,496 Total OPS (3,836,212 domestic)
